THESE REFER TO THE DIFFERENT SIZES OF PLANTS

Example only, letters are (e g k) e = 9cm pot. (the smallest size)

g= Med pot size 1:Lt volume. k= the largest size.

The plants in the medium or large size pot are bigger and/ or older by 6 to 12 months then the smaller size.
