Words of Warning.

Beware of rampant thugs in your pond!

We have found to our own sad experience and costly labour charges that there are a few undesirables water plants that we will not sell and can only be described as rampant thugs !

1) Tilleae recurva. or Crassula ssp Oxygenator / pond edging plant very invasive & uncontrollable when it escapes the pond into your garden.

2)Nymphoides peltata / Benettii/ Villarsia nymphoides.

Common name **Water Fringe**. Still listed by some Wild Life Conservation Trusts, far too invasive for general use, each leaf node forms another plant.

3) Ranunculus ligua grandiflora far too invasive with creeping root stock it spreads from one side of the pond to the other, and is quite at home in your herbaceous border!.
